MOUNTAINZONES

Park City Mountain Resort wants you to experience all that our mountain has to offer. That is why we've introduced our new color-coded Mountainzones Trail Map. Each Mountainzone features a variety of terrain so nearly every ability level can enjoy the area.

Payday / Town Mountainzone

The PayDay Mountainzone connects the mountain to Park City's historic Main Street. This Mountainzone features the King's Crown and PayDay terrain parks as well as the NASTAR course. This Mountainzone is served via the PayDay Hi-Speed Six-Pack and the Town lift. The runs Quit 'N Time and Creole provide additional access to historic Main Street.

Crescent Mountainzone

The Crescent Mountainzone offers very diverse terrain as it services our main beginner learning area and some of our premier Signature Runs™. You'll also find the Eagle Superpipe and the Pick 'N Shovel terrain park. This Mountainzone is served via the Ski Team, Three Kings and First Time lifts.

King Con Mountainzone

The King Con Mountainzone provides the most intermediate terrain in one Mountainzone. Perfect for intermediate skiers/riders, the King Con Mountainzone offers immaculately groomed runs great for practicing carving turns. Intermediate ideal for learning to skid the moguls. This Mountainzone is served via the Eagle and Silver Star lifts and the King Con Hi-Speed Quad.

Silverlode / Bonanza Mountainzone

The Silverlode/Bonanza Mountainzone is perfect for all ability levels and serves as the gateway to the mountain as it accesses a majority of the mountain from the Summit. Beginners will enjoy Claim Jumper and Homerun; intermediates will like Assessment and Powder Keg; most advanced should check out our Signature Runs® Dynamite and Lost Prospector. This Mountainzone is served via the Silverlode and Bonanza Hi-Speed Six-Packs.

Thaynes / Motherlode Mountainzone

The newly created Motherlode Meadows area provides pristine skiing/riding for advanced levels. The trees off of the upper portion of Jupiter Access provide fantastic tree skiing/riding. 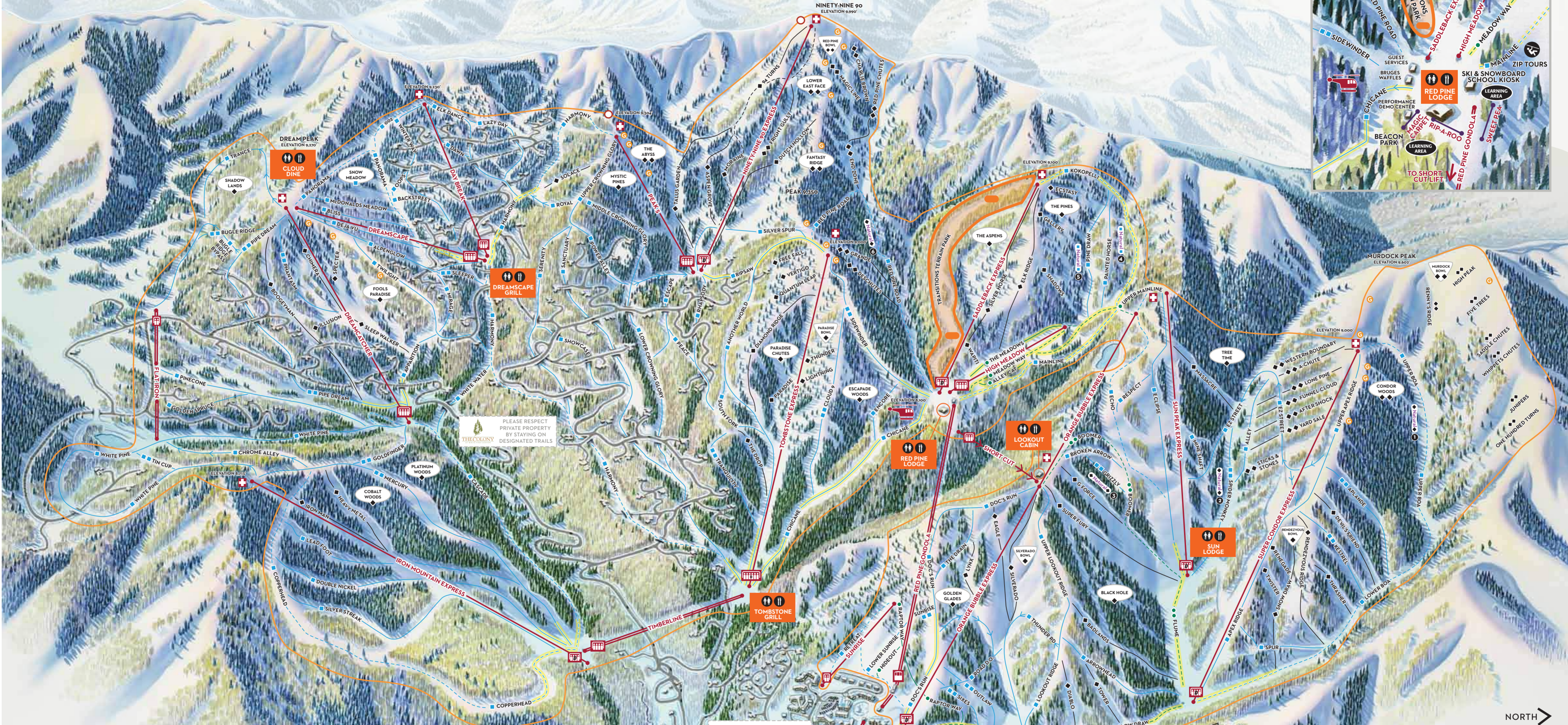
McConkey's / Pioneer Mountainzone

CANYONS SKIER/RIDER RESPONSIBILITY CODE	
1.	Always stay in control and avoid excessive speed. You must be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2.	People ahead of you have the right-of-way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3.	Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
4.	Before starting downhill or merging onto a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5.	If you are involved in an accident or collision, you must exchange contact information with the other party.
6.	Always use proper devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
7.	Observe and obey all posted signs and warnings.
8.	Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
9.	You must have sufficient physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload lifts.
10.	You may not ski or snowboard at Canyons if you are impaired by drugs or alcohol.
